<p>The tour begins with a visit to the San Pedro hill with its emblematic christ statue where we enjoy a panoramic view of the city.</p> <p>We go on to “La Cancha”, the biggest market of Cochabamba. There we will get to know a variety of typical products of the different ecological tiers of the Cochabamba region, traditional medicine, hand-crafts and the daily life of the vendors.</p> <p>At lunchtime we dive into the culinary world of Cochabamba. In the city center we will enjoy some typical dishes of the local gastronomy which is famous in the whole of the country.</p> <p>For digesting we take a stroll on the main plaza “14 de septiembre” and briefly visit the cathedral. Then we visit the convent of Santa Teresa.</p> <p>To wrap things up, we visit “Palacio Portales”, an eclectic mansion built by tin-baron Simón I. Patiño.</p> <p>Transfer to the hotel and/or airport.</p> <p>Lunch included.</p>
