<p>The tour begins with a visit to the San Pedro hill with its emblematic christ statue where we enjoy a panoramic view of the city.</p> <p>Then, depending on the weekday, we will visit either Santa Teresa convent or Palacio Portales, the mansion of the tin baron Simon I Patiño, which is now a cultural center. To finish, we continue to “La Cancha”, the biggest market of Cochabamba. There we will get to know a variety of typical products of the different ecological tiers of the Cochabamba region, traditional medicine, handicrafts and the daily life of the vendors.</p> <p>End of the tour, transfer to your hotel or the airport.</p> <p>Option: If you prefer, we will visit the city center with Plaza Coolen square, the main square and the cathedral instead of Santa Teresa or Palacio Portales.</p>
