<p><b>Day 1: Cochabamba – Villa Tunari</b></p>	<p><b>Foto: River crossing in Carrasco National Park</b></p>
<p>In the morning we drive for approx. 4 hours to the Chapare (tropical part of Cochabamba). After lunch we visit Carrasco National Park. On a hike through the jungle we visit caves that house the “Guácharos”, a kind of blind birds, and several species of bats.</p> <p>Then we visit an orchid garden and small museum in Villa Tunari and settle into the hotel.</p> <p>Lunch and dinner included.</p>

<p><b>Option 1:</b> Boat ride from Puerto San Francisco, with the possibility of fishing (depending on the season) or swimming in the river.</p> <p><b>Option 2:</b> Rafting on the Espíritu Santo River. This option has an additional fee of 20 \$us per person.</p> <p>Return to Cochabamba.</p> <p>Breakfast and lunch included.</p>
