



VALLE ALTO AND CITY TOUR COCHABAMBA (CV-01)

<p>Morning: Valle Alto</p>	<p>Foto: Convent in Tarata</p>
<p>In the morning we head to the Valle Alto (high valley), where our trip takes us to the rural roots of Cochabamba's society. In the villages of the area we will be able to appreciate living traditions, colonial and religious architecture, farmers' markets and a lot more.</p> <p>Our visit begins in the small colonial town of Tarata, which was once the capital of Bolivia. We visit the church (depending on its irregular opening hours) and the Franciscan convent. Then we go on to the village of Huayculi, where the thousand years old tradition of pottery is kept alive, and visit a potter's workshop. Then we pass through the village of Cliza and head to La Angostura lake to have lunch in a typical whose specialty is fish. Then we head back to Cochabamba for the city tour.</p>

<p>The city tour begins with a visit to "La Cancha", the biggest market of Cochabamba. There we will get to know a variety of typical products of the different ecological tiers of the Cochabamba region, traditional medicine, handicrafts and the daily life of the vendors. Then we head to the north of the town where we visit the mansion of the tin baron Simón I. Patiño, which is now a cultural centre.</p> <p>We finish the tour with a visit to the San Pedro hill with its emblematic christ statue where we enjoy a panoramic view of the city just before sunset.</p> <p>End of the tour, transfer to the hotel or airport.</p>

The entries to churches and museums are subject to their opening hours. On Sundays Santa Teresa convent and Palacio Portales are closed and we will visit the city center with the main square and cathedral instead.
