




## TORO TORO (TT-01, TT-02)

<p><b>Day 1: Cochabamba – Toro Toro - 7 Vueltas</b></p>	<p><b>Image: Toro Toro Village</b></p>
<p>Departure from Cochabamba to Toro Toro in the morning (aprox. 4,5 hrs. trip). On the way, we will pass through the colonial village of Tarata and stop for a short visit before continuing.</p> <p>Arrival at Toro Toro at noon, check-in at our accommodation where we enjoy a delicious lunch.</p> <p>In the afternoon we hike to 7 Vueltas to see marine fossils and spectacular views of the village of Toro Toro and the surrounding landscape.</p> <p>Overnight in Toro Toro.</p> <p>Lunch and dinner included.</p>	
<p><b>Day 2: Umajalanta Cave – City of Itas</b></p>	<p><b>Image: Cave in the City of Itas</b></p>
<p>After breakfast we head to Ciudad de Itas (City of Itas) about 20 km from Toro Toro. We hike through the impressive rock formations (canyons, caves, etc.) and enjoy the fantastic landscape.</p> <p>Box lunch after the hike.</p> <p>In the afternoon we explore Umajalanta cave during a challenging and exciting circuit (aprox. 2 h) with a lot of surprises.</p> <p>Overnight in Toro Toro.</p> <p>All meals included.</p>	
<p><b>Día 3: Dinosaur Tracks - El Vergel - Cochabamba</b></p>	<p><b>Image: Viewpoint at Toro Toro Canyon</b></p>
<p>In the morning we visit the fossilized dinosaur tracks at Cerro Huayllas near the village. Then we head for the viewpoint at Toro Toro Canyon for some spectacular views. If we're lucky we might be able to observe the endangered red-fronted Macaw.</p> <p>Then we hike down into the canyon to El Vergel waterfalls where we have the possibility to swim in the river (bring bathing suit and towel).</p> <p>After lunch, we return to Cochabamba, transfer to your hotel or airport.</p> <p>Breakfast and lunch included</p>
