The tour of the Valle Bajo (Low Valley) of Cochabamba leads us to the remains of ancient civilizations that inhabited the area and the beginnings of the colonial era in the valley.

In the morning we head to the town of Quillacollo and visit the famous Urcupiña shrine which hosts an important religious festival in mid-August every year.


Then we visit the archaeological site of the "qollqas" (silos) of Cotapachi and learn about the sophisticated food storage technology of the Inca.

Then we enjoy a typical lunch in Quillacollo. Afterwards we visit the Inca site of Incaraqay where we enjoy a panoramic view of the whole valley.

Then we return to Cochabamba and stop briefly in the small town of El Paso to visit the first church built in the valley of Cochabamba during the colonial era.
